## Proposed Pipeline Route

The purpose of the proposed Bluewater Texas Terminal, or BWV, project is to construct and operate an offshore deepwater port providing safe, economical and environmentally sustainable solutions for the export of domestic crude oil. The proposed project includes pipeline infrastructure along onshore, inshore and offshore routes - approximately 55 miles total

We designed our project to minimize the impact on the environment, wildlife and cultural resources, including:

- Use of existing utility pipeline routes and the avoidance of sensitive areas.
- Careful consideration was given in selecting locations for all project components.
- We were deliberate in the use of best available technologies such as Horizontal Directional Drilling.
- Reduce the need for offshore reverse lightering.

## Pipeline Safety

Pipelines remain one of the safest ways to deliver the energy we use every day. Based on the Department of Transportation [Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration](#) data, 99.999% of the crude oil, fuels and other product delivered through out pipelines arrive at their destination without incident. Proactive inspections, preventative maintenance, 24/7 monitoring, rapid shutdown and emergency response methods are put in

place to ensure pipelines are operating safely.
